

The Sacred Triduum

What is the Sacred Triduum?

After the celebration of Passion Sunday (Palm Sunday) the Catholic Church universal enters into Holy Week.

The week culminates with the celebration of the Sacred Triduum (Three Holy Days) of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter.

Each day of the Sacred Triduum is unique and celebrates the final days Christ shares with His Apostles. It is a time for us to go deeper in our own faith and share in the beautiful acts of love and compassion with Christ. The **Triduum** begins at Saint Katharine Drexel Parish with the Mass of the Lord's Supper celebrated on **Holy Thursday, March 28 at 7:00 pm.**

This Mass mirrors for us the **three pillars of Mother Drexel: Prayer, Learning and Service.** Obviously, the Mass, the greatest form of our **Prayer** gathers the faithful to remember the very institution of two great events: the Institution of the Priesthood and the celebration of the very First Eucharist. In this Mass, Christ teaches His disciples what it is He is calling them to do **(Learning)** and humbles Himself in the great act of love by washing their feet, to become the Servant of All. His example teaches them to go forth and serve. **(Service)**

We all can remember our First Holy Communion, it was a day filled with great joy. Our families most probably dressed up extra-special that day, especially the first communicant girls in their white dresses and the boys sharply dressed in suits. The day began in Church with Mass and for many continued celebrating at home with family!

For those who are **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion**, this day too, celebrates the very essence of your ministry. As an Extraordinary Minister you are not only there to help distribute holy communion at Mass, but also are able to take Christs' Body to the homebound and in some cases even administering it as Viaticum, spiritual food to strengthen a dying person for the journey from this world to life after death. What a privilege and beautiful ministry you are able to share.

So then, the invitation to celebrate the Sacred Triduum is extended to **everyone**. Yes, it may mean sacrificing some time on the family calendar and prioritizing or re-scheduling things at home so that our entire Parish Family can gather and celebrate **all Three Days: Holy Thursday**—**Good Friday**—**Easter.**

As Christ showed us so many acts of love, can we not offer him our time and hearts by being present and celebrating these Three Holy Days? See you and your family in church.

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fasting and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are all three traditional disciplines of Lent. The Faithful, the Elect and those Candidates preparing for Reception into Full Communion in the Catholic Church should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.


